## Rules and Regulations

The following rules and regulations apply to all Counselor in Training (CIT) Leadership Program participants. By applying for the Counselor in Training Leadership Program, you acknowledge and agree to abide by these rules without exception. **Do not submit an application unless you can and will comply with these rules.** For safe and orderly operation of the camp, they will be strictly enforced.

**Drugs, Tobacco and Alcohol:** The use or possession of alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs of any kind is forbidden. Any illegal activity, including use or possession of illegal drugs or supplying drugs, alcohol or tobacco in any form to minors will be reported to the proper law enforcement agency and will result in your session being terminated without warning.

**Child Abuse:** Corporal punishment or any form of physical, emotional or sexual abuse, or any endangerment of a camper or fellow CIT will not be tolerated, and is grounds for immediate dismissal.

**Grooming:** Each CIT shall be clean shaven and present a neat appearance at all times. Beards, goatees, extreme or unconventional hair styles (including long hair on men) and/or color are not acceptable. Earrings on men or body piercing will not be permitted. No tattoos are allowed. All clothing will be neat and appropriate for the day's activity. No inappropriate, violent or crude logos on clothing allowed.

**Personal Belongings:** Gold Arrow Camp is not responsible for the personal belongings of any CIT while in or out of camp, if lost, or damaged by fire, theft, laundry, etc. We encourage you **not** to bring jewelry or expensive personal items to camp.

**Use of Camp Equipment:** CITs are not permitted to use camp equipment except when participating in an organized camp activity led by a qualified instructor.

**Language:** CITs are not permitted to use bad language, gestures, or off color stories.

**Boundaries:** CITs are not permitted to leave camp boundaries unless under the supervision of the CIT Director.

**Sexual Contact:** CITs are not permitted to have sexual contact with other CITs, staff members, or campers.

**Visitors:** CITs may not have visitors at camp.

**Vehicles:** CITs may not drive personal vehicles to camp, nor may they drive with unauthorized Gold Arrow staff members.

**Discipline of Campers:** CITs are not staff members and therefore are not given the authority to reprimand or punish campers.

By submitting this application, I agree to abide by all camp rules and regulations. I understand that failure to comply will result in disciplinary action up to termination of my Counselor in Training Leadership Program session at Gold Arrow Camp.
